Saved from the auction block in 1988 by the nonprofit citizens' group Our Fair Carousel Inc., the ride had continued to be a treasured Minnesota attraction, operating in Saint Paul's beautiful Como Park since October of 1999. Plus, there was the wonderfully restored Wurlitzer 153 organ!
